What is the rapture?




The word “rapture” means to be caught up. In *I Thessalonians 4:17* it says, “Then we which are a _____ and remain shall be **caught up** together with them in the clouds, to m_____



the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.” Jesus right now, is in heaven with God the Father. Someday He will come and we will be caught up with Christ. Think of it as a magnet that is a few inches above a bunch of metal and plastic paper clips. All the metal paper clips are caught up with the powerful magnet, while the plastic paper clips stay. That is what the rapture is like. When we are caught up with Christ, we will also receive a perfect body. *I Corinthians 15:51*, “Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all s_____ (die), but we shall all be changed,”

Who is going with Christ?







In just a quick moment in *I Corinthians 15:52*, “In a m_____, in the twinkling of an e____, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”



Luke 17:24 says, “For as the l_____, that lighteneth out of the one part under heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in his d____.” It will be as fast as lightning and a twinkling or blink of an eye. There will be no time to get saved that quick when the trumpet blows. It will happen so fast that, *Luke 17:35-36* says, “Two w_____ shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left. ³⁶ Two m____ shall be in the f_____ ; the one shall be taken, and the other left.” There is no time for a second chance for the rapture. Once it is done it is gone. We do not have to worry about missing it if we are saved. It will be the quickest thing that has ever happened before!

Where is it going to happen?

Jesus is coming back in the clouds. *I Thessalonians 4:17*, “Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the c_____, to meet the Lord in the a____: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.”


