It's Time to Take a Stand for the Truth

I am writing today to give you some urgent prayer requests and ask you to take some action. The Bible tells us we are to pray for our leaders and I do, but it also tells us that we are to stand for the Lord. In the news you are hearing about the senate committee hearings and the push by our President to change **the Don't Ask Don't Tell policy** in the military. You need to understand what this is about and how it will affect our military and our ministry.

In 1993 Congress passed a law, Section 654, Title 10, U.S.C. that states that homosexuals are not eligible for military service. Thus it is against the law for them to serve in the military. Then the President at that time issued an executive order that compromised this law by dropping the question about homosexuality that used to appear on the induction forms, thus we have the DADT policy.

What they are pushing for now

is to change the law and allow homosexuals to serve openly in our military. One with any sense can just imagine what this will do to military readiness of our armed forces. Now think about the God called chaplains and what this will mean to them. Chaplains will be pressured not to oppose this life style and our chaplains will be furthers isolated as they stand for truth. Things like tolerance and political correctness will cause many problems when it comes to daily ministry, let alone advancement and promotions.
