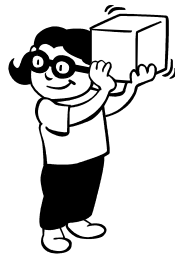

We are collecting gifts for orphans in Choluteca, Honduras. Please put them in a shoe box. Wrap the top and bottom separately. Do not seal. Some gift ideas are: little toys, crayons, socks, hard candies, and any other small gifts for children. A good way to do this is to have your children pick out gifts to put in the box. Place a tag with gender and age of child, and \$4 (for shipping costs) in the box. In addition, we are collecting non-perishable food: rice, beans, canned goods, etc. to stock the shelves of the orphanage.
