## Duty is Love

There are many definitions of love in the Bible. There are 16 just in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8. Love is like a big beautiful multi-faceted diamond.

Included in the definitions of love is duty. When a soldier does his/her duty we call that love of country. A dutiful wife shows her love for her children and husband that way. A dutiful husband works at a factory for 40 years and in so doing proves his love to his wife and kids.

Duty is one of the greatest ways we show love. The longevity of a bus worker, teacher, pastor, piano player, nursery worker, treasurer, choir director, etc. in a local church shows their love for God and His people. (2 Chronicles 8:14)

Solomon said in Ecclesiastes 17:13, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man." Jesus taught that keeping His commandments is another facet of love. John 14:23 says, "If a man love me, he will keep my words...". John 14:15 says, "If ye love me keep my commandments".

Jesus, like Solomon equated commandments and duty. Luke 17:10 says, "So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do."

Paul talked of our duty in the Christian life: Romans 15:27 says, "It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things."
