SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

Geo Walton.

Signer #55: George Walton (1741-1804)

Georgia. Age at signing: 35

Occupation: Lawyer

Married: Dorothy (2 children)

Quotes & Notes:

Walton continued his service in Congress until 1778, when he was appointed to be a colonel in the Georgia militia.

In the battle for Savannah, while he was commanding a battalion on the right of General Howe's army, he was shot through the thigh and knocked off his horse. The British captured him and took him as a prisoner of war. After being held nine months, he was released by prisoner exchange for a British navy captain in September, 1779.

He died on February 2, 1804, at the age of 63, at his home in Augusta, Georgia. In the words of a biographer, who lived at the time of his death, "Judge Walton was universally beloved by those who knew him intimately, and the carpenter's apprentice became the most exalted citizen of the Commonwealth in which he resided. Even at this late day, the remembrance of his services and exalted character, is fresh in the hearts of the people."
